The History

The St. Johns Bank Excellence Scholarship Program was started in 1987 at Ritenour High School, located just blocks from St. Johns' Main Bank. In 2000, the program was expanded to include six local high schools that are located within each bank branch's home. In 2006 and 2020, the St. Johns Bank Excellence Program expanded again adding more school districts. The scholarship program will now accept applications from qualifying seniors attending any public or private high school within the Francis Howell School District, Fort Zumwalt School District, St. Charles School District, Pattonville School District, Ferguson/Florissant School District, Orchard Farm School district, Hazelwood School district, Wentzville School district and the Ritenour School District.

The Program

The St. Johns Bank Excellence Scholarship Program is for high school seniors who are continuing their education full-time (12 hours or more) at a community college, 4-year college or university located in the states of Missouri, Illinois, or Kansas and planning to major in Banking, Finance, or Business Administration. The scholarships can be used for tuition, room and board, or books.

The Award

St. Johns Bank Excellence Program will award a total of three scholarships, worth \$1,000 each, to qualifying candidates. We award one scholarship to a St. Charles County high school senior, one to a St. Louis County high school senior and one to a senior at Ritenour High School in St. John. High school students qualified to receive the St. Johns Bank scholarship must attend a public or private high school in the Francis Howell School District, Fort Zumwalt School District, St. Charles School District, Pattonville School District, Ferguson/Florissant School District, Orchard Farm School district, Hazelwood School district, Wentzville School district and the Ritenour School District.

The Application
